FUND OBJECTIVE AND PHILOSOPHY

The BACCI SNN Equity Fund is an equity-focussed portfolio. The portfolio's objective is to create long-term wealth through a combination of income and capital growth of the underlying securitites held in the portfolio. The manager shall seek to achieve this objective by investing in local and global instruments. The portfolio's equity exposure will always exceed 80% of its net asset value.

FUND MANAGER COMMENTARY

Global stock markets were down 5% in January, one of the worst months since the global financial crisis. Brent crude oil is trading around \$90/pbb, levels last seen in 2014 and well above the unprecedented pandemic low of \$15/pbb in2020. Rising geopolitical tensions, particularly between Russia and the Ukraine, adding pressure to energy prices in the short-term. Global inflation is rising, as expected, and marks the end of central bank support, worldwide. This is a significant change to the dynamics of the markets. The prospect of higher interest rates combined with a slowdown in the rate of earnings growth, as well geopolitical tensions has impacted negatively on investor sentiment. Despite the volatility across global markets, domestic assets have had a solid start to the year. Local equity and bond markets are both up about 1% and the ZAR rallied by 3.5% against the US dollar. The forces at play in commodities and interest rates saw local resources and financials up over 3% each, while industrials declined by 2%.

Global economic growth is expected to moderate this year, but remains robust, which will support continued earnings recovery. Whist pandemic restrictions remain in force to varying degrees, the impact on economy activity is beginning to wane as the virus becomes endemic. The key question is, has inflation peaked and where will it settle. While supply chain issues still remain, which is certainly inflationary in the short-term, the bottlenecks should improve throughout the year. Energy may stay higher for longer. The labour force is more tricky as wage pressure can be a more permanent form of inflation. As central banks navigate around this, market volatility is likely to remain high, especially in the more expensive markets such as the USA. The domestic equity valuations remain attractive, both on a historical basis and compared to emerging markets.

In a period of heightened volatility, fundamental analysis matters more than ever. We remain convinced that superior stock selection will ensure good returns. We continue to identify attractive stock selection opportunities for the fund, both locally and abroad, to ensure that we can provide solid and consistent returns over time.




RISK PROFILE







Annualised Return is the weighted average compound growth rate over the performance period measured

Highest & Lowest Return The highest and lowest rolling twelve-month performance of the portfolio since inception

Total Expense Ratio (TER) reflects the percentage of the average Net Asset Value (NAV) of the portfolio that was incurred as charges, levies and fees related to the management of the portfolio. A higher TER does not necessarily imply a poor return, nor does a low TER imply a good return. The current TER cannot be regarded as an indication of future TER's.

Transaction Costs (TC) is the percentage of the value of the Fund incurred as costs relating to the buying and selling of the Fund's underlying assets. Transaction costs are a necessary cost in administering the Fund and impacts Fund returns

Total Investment Charges (TIC%) = TER (%) + TC (%): The Total Investment Charges (TIC), the TER + the TC, is the percentage of the net asset value of the class of the Financial Product incurred as costs relating to the investment of the Financial Product. It should be noted that a TIC is the sum of two calculated ratios (TER+TC).

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
